4. Adding Student Accounts - Click on Add New Students.
5. You will be asked how many student accounts you wish to create.

6. Your student accounts will be created. They will be assigned a username and password. The account information will be emailed to the email address you setup your account with. They will also be available in the messaging section of your dashboard.

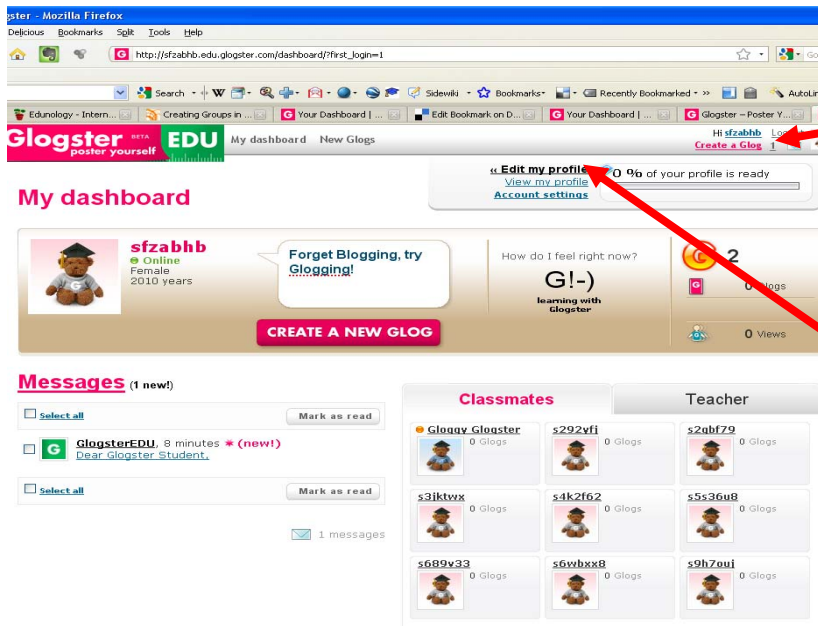


## 9. Editing a student profile
